Monday, 01/16 Tuesday, 01/17	* <u>THE WORLD FAMOUS GLENN MILLER ORCHESTRA</u> – Glenn Miller believed a band ought to have a sound of its own, which he called personality. Formed in 1956, the Glenn Miller Orchestra, with its unique jazz and swing sounds, has been touring worldwide ever since. With songs like “Moonlight Serenade”, “Tuxedo Junction” and “Chattanooga Choo--Choo”, they are as American as apple pie.
Monday, 01/23 Tuesday, 01/24	* <u>FRED MOYER JAZZ TRIO</u> – This incredible trio of piano, bass and drums play note by note transcriptions of some of the greatest jazz ever written. Most of the great classical composers were excellent improvisers, and many compositions started life as improvisations. Theme and variations, a common form in classical music is the model for most jazz.
Monday, 01/30 Tuesday, 01/31	* <u>ESCHER STRING QUARTET</u> – In its hometown of New York, the ensemble with two violins, viola and cello serves as season artists of The Chamber Music Society of Lincoln Center, where it has presented the complete Zemlinsky Quartets Cycle. It also is one of five quartets chosen to collaborate in a complete presentation of Beethoven’s string quartets.
Monday, 02/13 Tuesday, 02/14	* <u>RISING STAR CONCERT—DEREK WANG, PIANIST</u> - Derek Wang is a New York-based pianist and communicator. In 2020 he launched a podcast series <i>American Stories</i> with violinist Sophia Stoyanovich. The series examines and celebrates American identity through music in performance. Derek won First Prize in the New York Liszt Competition. He has performed in the Great Hall of the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the rotunda of the Guggenheim Museum, Lehrman Hall at the Morgan Library and Museum.
Monday, 02/20 Tuesday, 02/21	* <u>SPANISH BRASS</u> - With 30-plus years in the world of chamber music, Spanish Brass is one of the most dynamic groups on the international musical stage. In 2020, the ensemble received the Spanish National Music Award and three of its CDs were awarded with Carles Santos Awards.
Monday, 2/27 Tuesday, 2/28	* <u>WILLIAM HAGEN, violin</u> - A native of Salt Lake City, Utah, William began playing the violin at the age of four. In 2015, William won 3rd prize at the Queen Elisabeth Competition in Brussels. William Hagen has performed as soloist, recitalist, and chamber musician across the United States, Europe, Asia, and Latin America. In 2022/23, William performs with orchestras around the United States, makes his debut with the Orquesta Filharmónica de Bogotá, and performs as soloist and chamber musician in several countries in Europe.
