<p>Monday, 01/13 Tuesday, 01/14</p>	<p>* <u>An Evening of Dixieland Jazz with The Boilermaker Jazz Band</u> - Based in Pittsburgh, Boilermaker Jazz Band has been performing swing and hot jazz worldwide for over 30 years, with unique renditions of classic tunes. Led by Paul Cosentino on clarinet and saxes, this group always keeps the music fresh. Their enthusiastic performances from the Great American Songbook will make you want to dance in the aisles.</p>
<p>Monday, 01/20 Tuesday, 01/21</p>	<p>* <u>Concert of Famous Opera Highlights</u> - Featuring Chelea Guo, Soprano and José Luis Maldonado, baritone with Benedicte Jourdois, pianist. Prepare yourself for an evening of spine-tingling music performed by these amazing artists. Selections will include famous arias and duets from Carmen, La Traviata, The Barber of Seville, and Rogers and Hammerstein’s Carousel. (You might want to bring some Kleenex.)</p>
<p>Monday, 01/27 Tuesday, 01/28</p>	<p>* <u>Fred Moyer, Pianist</u> - The program will include Rachmaninoff’s Piano Concerto No. 3 (with recorded orchestra), Debussy’s Claire de Lune, and works by Mozart, Beethoven, and Liszt. During more than thirty years as a full-time concert virtuoso, Frederick Moyer has appeared as piano soloist with numerous world-renowned orchestras in all parts of the globe.</p>
<p>Monday, 02/10 Tuesday, 02/11</p>	<p>* <u>Trio Zimbalist</u> – Highlights will include the Arensky Piano Trio No. 1 and the Ravel Piano Trio in A minor. Czech Violinist Josef Špaček, Greek cellist Timotheos Gavriilidis and Chinese-American pianist George Xiaoyuan Fu are all distinguished alumni of the Curtis Institute of Music. Each is a sought-after soloist, performing around the world. Together they form an inimitable ensemble.</p>
<p>Monday, 02/17 Tuesday, 02/18</p>	<p>* <u>Rising Star Concert</u> – The program will include Beethoven’s Kreutzer Sonata and the Rondo in B minor by Schubert and other exciting works for violin and piano. At this year’s Rising Star Concert, we are in for a real treat, because the winners at the most prestigious competitions in the world for their instruments will play for us. Stella Chen, violinist won first prize at the Queen Elizabeth Competition, and George Li, pianist won the silver medal at the International Tchaikovsky Piano Competition.</p>
<p>Monday, 2/24 Tuesday, 2/25</p>	<p>* <u>Esmé String Quartet</u> - The performance features Mendelssohn’s String Quartet, Op. 80 and Ravel’s String Quartet. Based in Germany, the Esmé Quartet features South Korean violinists Wonhee Bae and Yuna Ha, recently joined by the prize-winning Belgian American violist Dimitri Murrath. Cellist Yeeun Heo completes the group as it continues its world-spanning tours.</p>
